Classes




Course One: Overview & Voter Registration

In addition to an overview of the history of voting & elections, individuals will learn that good elections start with good voter rolls. Processes of exactly how voter rolls are maintained will be discussed along with who is eligible to register to vote.



Course Two: Candidate Information

This course will cover how a candidate's name gets on the ballot along with many areas of campaign finance, including filing requirements, deadline and legal regulations. Qualifications for different contests will also be discussed during this class.



Course Three: Ballot & Machine Preparation

This course will walk individuals through the process of how paper ballots are created, tested and printed for the election. Also, students will learn how the ballot marking devices & scanners are prepared, tested and sealed in preparation for Election Day.



Course Four: Poll Workers, Media & Community Outreach

Individuals will learn the importance of those that work the elections and the training that goes into being a poll worker. Media coverage will also be discussed along with the tools available for staying in touch and obtaining information, including the WilsonVotes website and various social networking websites. Students will also learn how our office works to instill the importance of voting and how groups are learning at an early age how to vote and participate.
